A few reminders as we begin the term:

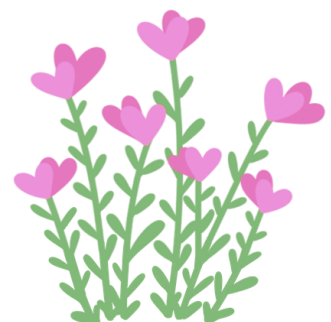
- Please ensure children arrive at school on time each day.

- Please keep us informed of any changes to contact details or important information.

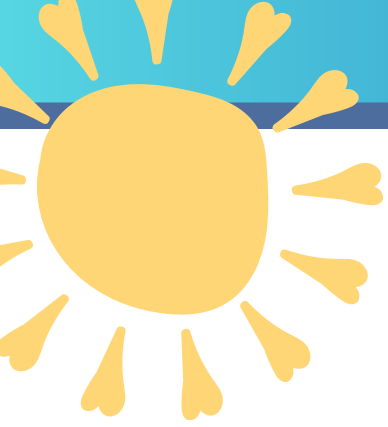
We value the strong partnership between home and school and thank you for your continued support. Working together helps us provide the very best for all of our children.

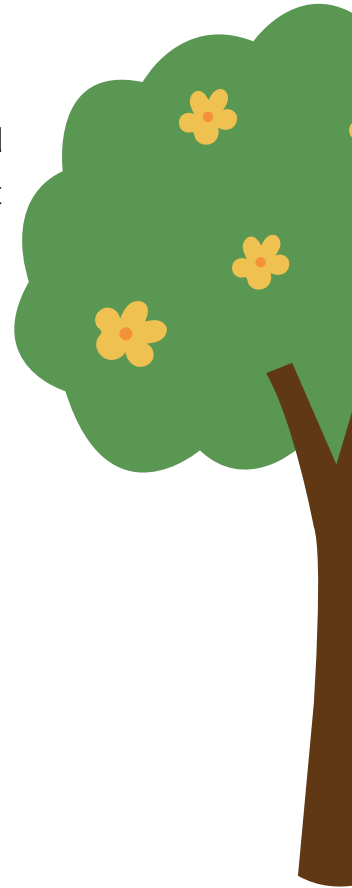




ROBOTIC LEARNING

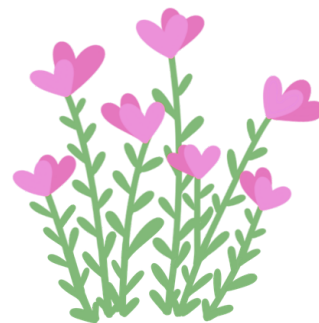


BEGGS CLOSE GATE

CONGRATULATIONS



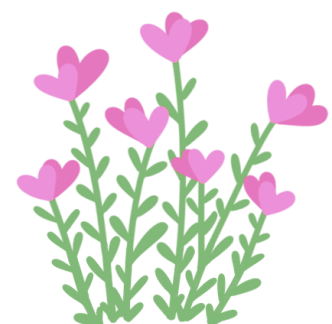
Bella and Olivia are over the moon to share that they have been signed to a leading children's talent agency for TV, film and musical theatre!!!
